

Speaker Profile: Nigel French



Nigel French is Professor of Food Safety and Veterinary Public Health at Massey University, New Zealand. He is Co-Director of the EpiCentre, which is one of the largest veterinary epidemiology groups in the world, and specializes in research and training in molecular epidemiology, food safety and the control of zoonotic diseases.

Nigel has published over 150 articles in peer-reviewed journals, including many on food-borne pathogens such as *Campylobacter*, *Salmonella* and *E. coli* O157. He has led a number of large-scale inter-disciplinary research programmes, combining microbiology, molecular biology and modeling, in both New Zealand and the United Kingdom. He holds a post as visiting professor and Honorary Research Fellow at the University of Liverpool, UK.
